Lesson plan

My college fair preparation



About this lesson

Students will make the most of their college fair experience with some pre-fair school research in Xello, followed by preparation of questions to ask college fair representatives during the fair. After the fair, students will reflect on their experience in a Xello assignment or survey and share their portfolio.

Learning objectives

By the end of this activity, students will:

- Research 5 school profiles in Xello that offer a major of interest to them
- Consider each school from the perspective of it being a target, stretch, or safety school
- Research entrance requirements and other information for their schools and search for scholarship options for each
- Prepare questions in advance of college fair attendance to help them have meaningful interactions with college representatives and gain insights into different schools
- Capture and share the information gathered from their research in <u>Xello</u> <u>Portfolios</u> and reflect on their college fair attendance to help refine college application plans

Inquiry prompts

- What is the purpose of a college fair? What are the benefits?
- What factors are most important to me when choosing a college (for instance, location, size, majors, campus life, costs)?
- How can I ensure that my college choices align with my personal and academic goals?

Before you begin

- Decide how you will share the <u>College fair preparation handout</u> (also available in <u>Spanish</u>) with your students (hard copy versus shared through **Assignments** in Xello). Review the worksheet and create the assignment or prepare the handout, accordingly.
- 2. Edit and distribute the <u>College fair flyer</u> (also available in <u>Spanish</u>), in advance of the event.
- Create a college fair <u>Survey</u> or <u>Assignment</u> in Xello for your students to complete after they attend the fair. Encourage students to share their completed Xello <u>Portfolios</u>.
 - Title the survey or assignment College fair reflections. Select from the following questions or create your own:
 - Was attending the fair a good use of your time?
 - Reflect on what you learned about your schools of interest, either in preparation for the event or during the fair. Did you learn any new or surprising information?

🞑 Xello entry point

It is recommended that students have an understanding of their financial aid options before completing this lesson. Check out the lesson <u>My college financial aid</u> <u>options</u> as a possible resource to assist with this. Students should also have at least 1 saved career.

- Completed Xello portfolio

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- What are your top school choices? Did speaking to the representatives change your opinion of any of the schools?
- Were your questions answered? If not, what questions do you still have?
- Were there schools not represented at the fair you wish had attended? If so, what other post-secondary option are you considering?
- Do you need help finding school contact information?
- How confident do you feel about applying for college?
- Which financial aid options are you considering to help you pay for college?
- Have you learned about any specialized college entrance or transition programs (first-generation, honors, bridge)?
- Outline 3 things you'll do next. Possible actions could include:
 - Scheduling a campus visit
 - Following up with a representative
 - Doing additional research on specific programs or financial aid

Teaching strategies

- Start by presenting and reviewing the <u>College fair flyer</u> (also available in <u>Spanish</u>), with your students.
- 2 Allow students five minutes to reflect on the following question:
 - What is the purpose of a college fair? What are the benefits?

Instruct students to log in to their Xello accounts and work through the <u>College fair preparation handout</u> (also available in <u>Spanish</u>). Remind them to save or bookmark their shared portfolio weblink so they can have their questions with them at the fair.

4 End the activity with a 10-minute class discussion using the inquiry prompts.

- What factors are most important to me when choosing a college (for instance, location, size, majors, campus life, costs)?
- How can I ensure that my college choices align with my personal and academic goals?
- 5 Don't forget to have students complete the Post-college fair Xello Survey or Assignment after attending the event.

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
