Inquiry Prompts

• When considering post-secondary education, what are my top priorities?

Before You Begin

- 1. Ensure that you are able to log into your student demo account in Xello.
- 2. Ensure that students are able to log into their accounts and access **Explore Options**.
- Decide whether to share directions and discussion reflections with your class via a slide deck and project for students to view, or on a whiteboard in the physical classroom.
- 4. Create a Xello **Assignment**. This is where students will submit their reflections at the end of the lesson.

Teaching Strategies

1 Ask students to consider the following question: what are my top priorities for my post-secondary education?

NOTE: Even if students don't think they'll pursue a college or university after high school, they never know where their future career may take them. Therefore, it can still be beneficial to explore schools that may be a good fit so that they have that knowledge no matter where life takes them.



3 Direct students to spend 15 minutes exploring schools in **Explore Options**. The goal is to save at least 3 schools by the end of their exploration, while also keeping track of their reasons for saving a school. Following their search, have them share these factors with their classmates. Provide students with the following tips to help with their search:

- If you've already saved a school in Xello, review the school profile and note a couple reasons why you chose to save it.
- If you've already saved a program in Xello, look at a few school profiles that offer the program or a related program. Why would you choose one school over the other?
- In **Explore Schools**, use **More Filters** to search schools within a set of parameters. What filters did you apply? Why are these factors important to you?

Materials Required

- Computers or tablets with Internet access
- Whiteboard and whiteboard markers (optional)

Artifacts

Students:

- save at least 3 schools in Explore Options
- reflect on their postsecondary education priorities

After 15 minutes, bring the whole class back together. If you have a larger class you may want to divide the class into smaller groups to ensure everyone has time to share. Lead a round robin style discussion that gets each person to share one of their top factors when saving a school.
