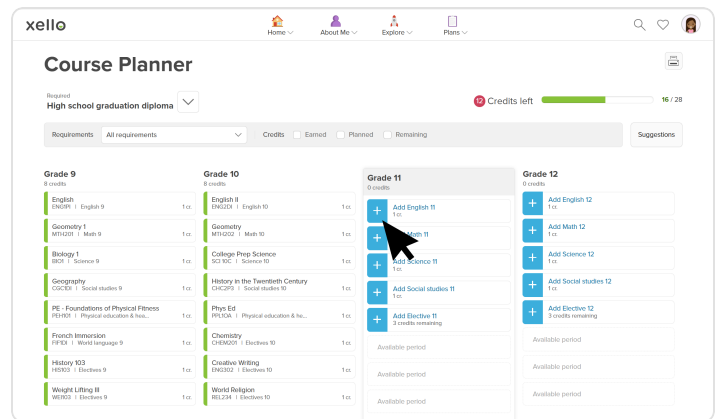

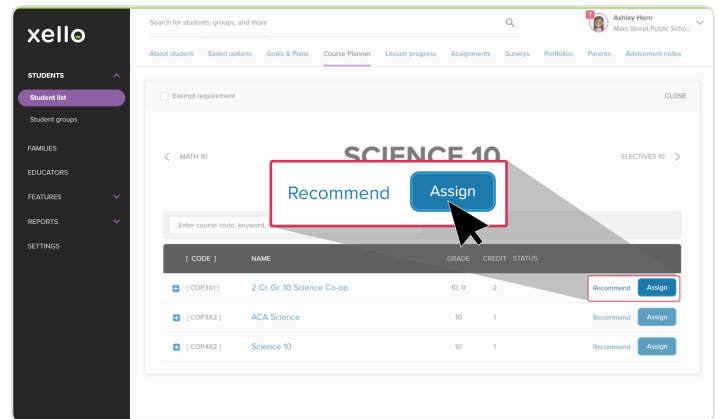

About Course Planner

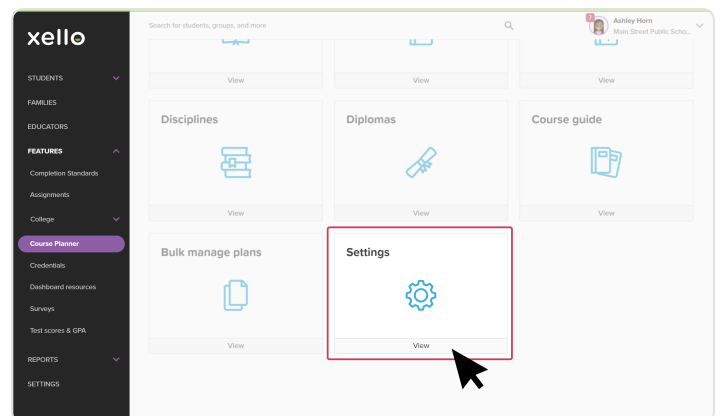

Educators can provide personalized support by approving plans, assigning courses, applying exemptions, and optimizing selections to keep students on track.



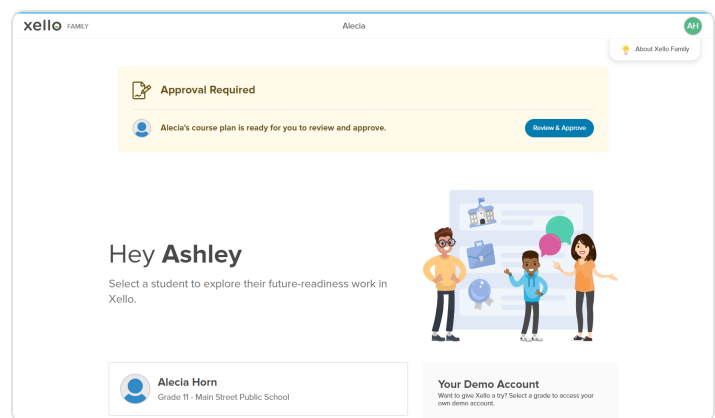
Xello Administrators maintain full oversight of the academic pathways by configuring courses, disciplines, and specialized diploma tracks to match district requirements.



Why use Course Planner

Course Planner makes it easy for your district to stay organized while giving students more control. It's built to match your specific rules so that everyone stays on track with less effort.

- **Customized to your district or schools:** Tailored to your graduation requirements (including CTE courses, pathways, and multiple diploma tracks).
- **Self-guided student experience:** Xello's course planner is user-friendly and because it's customized to your requirements, your students can complete and submit their course selections with little-to-no intervention.
- **Parent approval:** If **Xello Family** accounts are enabled, parents can digitally sign off on completed course plans.
- **Export course plans:** Submitted course plans can be exported from Xello and (depending on your SIS) be imported into your SIS for help with future schedule creation.

Built-in accountability

Monitor 4-year plan progress and parent approvals by assigning **Course Planner** tasks through **Completion Standards** so they appear as items in the student to-do lists.



Educator tools and overrides

Counselors and staff are able to exempt students from certain requirements, bulk manage course plans, approve special requests, and submit incomplete plans if necessary.



Reporting and tracking

Use real-time reports to monitor plan completion, course demand, and critical alerts, while exporting course plans electronically or as PDFs for parent signatures.

This data gets exported from your Student information System (SIS) and sent to us. Use our data definition support or API articles for help on how to send us your course data. 2. Your most recent Course Guide or Catalog. This should include: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Course names and descriptions • Credit values • Grade levels offered • Graduation requirements • Prerequisites 3. The answers to a Questionnaire we'll provide you. Your responses will help us configure Course Planner to reflect your district's course structure, scheduling model, and graduation requirements. <p>*Note for districts using Infinite Campus: the SIS Infinite Campus requires an annual fee of \$500 to generate the course data transfers and imports.</p>
<p>2</p> <p>Data entry</p> <p>2-4 weeks</p>	<p>The Xello team will enter all courses, diplomas, and disciplines into Xello based on your course guide.</p>
<p>3</p> <p>7-step setup</p> <p>2-4 weeks</p>	<p>Review the data entry to make sure everything is just right!
